

Confidential Guidance Department Online Appointment Booking System

To book a 30-minute appointment:

1. Go to the Springbank Community High School's website
2. Click on the "Guidance" tab to the left of the screen
3. Click on the "Book an Appointment" button
4. Select either Ms. Lambie (gr. 11&12), Ms. Smid (gr. 9&10) or Ms. Cochran (Career Advisor)
5. Follow the prompts - students are to use their rvs google e-mail address

If it is an urgent matter, students and/or parents are to:

1. Stop into guidance and the situation will be assessed and a plan created
2. Phone the guidance office or front office directly
3. Contact administration

If it is a five-minute matter:

1. Stop into guidance at lunchtime and speak with a member of the guidance team.

If it is a matter that does not require a face-to-face appointment and is non-urgent:

1. Send an e-mail to the appropriate member of the guidance department
2. Leave a voice mail in the appropriate mailbox
