Important: Deadlines

- o As stated in the grad booklet, Gr. 12 students need to be “on-track” to graduate as of May 1.
- o Students must be passing gr. 12 pre-requisite courses (April 16) and be 70% complete on-line learning courses by May 1.

- o All grade 12 students should have a working My Pass account with Alberta Education.
- o This account is necessary for students to see diploma marks, view and order transcripts
- o If this account is linked to an rvschool e-mail – please change the e-mail address before the end of June.
