You child's place in each program is secured via a first-come-first served process, so please ensure that forms are submitted as soon as possible. ***If you anticipate that your child will be involved in extracurricular events that must attend on these dates, such as sport tryouts, they MUST sign up for the local trips.*** Your child may still sign up for the local overnight trip if involved in such activities, but parents/guardians are responsible for transporting their child from and back to the camp if they need to leave the camp site to participate in a practice or game.

**Please check one:**

- A series of day trips to a local camp destination (no overnight). (approx. cost \$50 - 100)
- A 3-day, two-night trip to Camp Horizon in Kananaskis Country (approx. cost \$300).
- 3-day, two-night trip to the Goldeye Centre in Nordegg. (approx. cost \$350)
