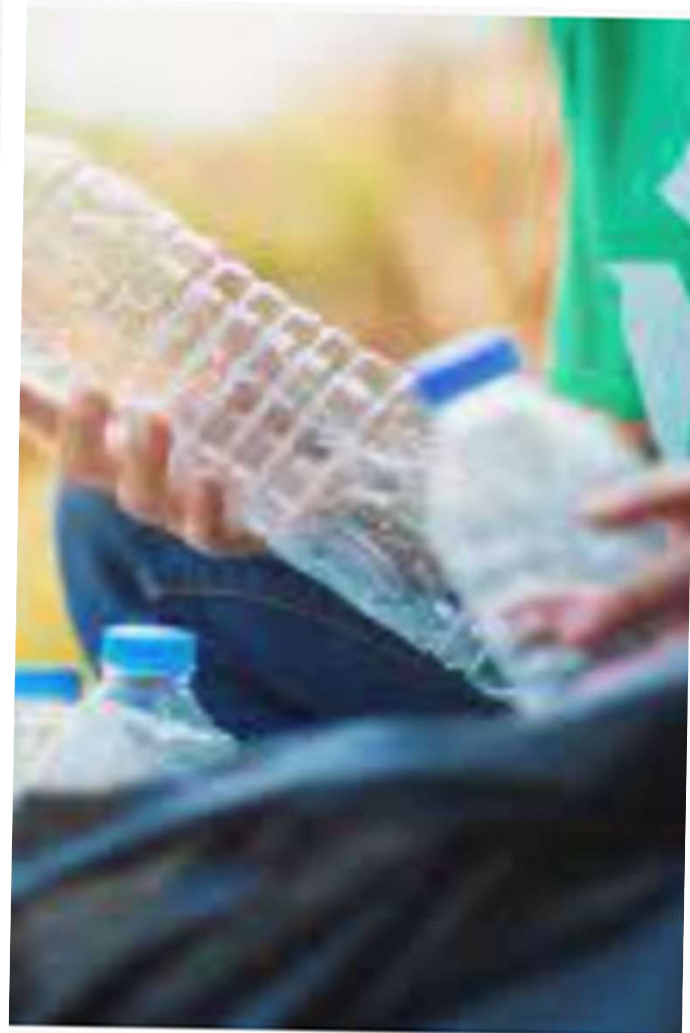

Post-Secondary Applications: Closing Dates

- o U of C – applications close March 1
- o Many post-secondary applications are closing... pay attention!

Important: Deadlines

- o As stated in the grad booklet, Gr. 12 students need to be “on-track” to graduate as of May 1.
- o Students must be passing gr. 12 pre-requisite courses (April 16) and be 70% complete on-line learning courses by May 1.

Transcripts

- o Most Universities will accept your Detailed Academic Report (upload it in your university student account)
- o If a transcript is to be mailed directly from the school – order forms are available from **Ms. Thiessen** in Guidance.
- o Official transcripts must be ordered from student My Pass account. The cost is \$10.

My Pass

- o All grade 12 students should have a working My Pass account with Alberta Education.
- o This account is necessary for students to see diploma marks, view and order transcripts
- o If this account is linked to an rvschool e-mail – please change the e-mail address before the end of June.

Letters of Admission

- o Confirm your acceptance and make a payment
- o Know how to register for classes – details are provided in your offer of admissions letter
- o Apply for residence if needed

Financing Your Education

- o Discuss a plan with your parents
- o Update your resume and look for summer work
- o Consider federal and provincial student loans
- o Continue scholarship research and applications
