2022 Update

Diploma exams for the rest of the school year (April, June and August 2022)

Diploma exams are expected to be administered for the rest of the school year (April, June and August 2022). The situation will continue to be monitored and the advice of the Chief Medical Officer of Health will inform final decisions.

Students who were intending to rewrite a diploma exam in January 2022 and are not taking the course can register to rewrite in April 2022.

2021/22 diploma exam weighting

- Due to learning disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the weighting of diploma exams will be temporarily reduced to 10% for the 2021/22 school year only.

The 10% diploma exam weighting is for the current school year only

This change is only temporary to address the learning disruptions that some students have experienced due to COVID-19.

This temporary change will not lower diploma exam standards

The expectation for what students must learn remains the same.

The same processes used to develop high-quality diploma exams worth 30% are being used to develop diploma exams worth 10%.

The teacher, as well as the diploma exam, address outcomes from the same program of studies and are both expected to apply appropriate achievement standards.

Diploma Exam Schedule

June 2022

Diploma exams **must** be administered in accordance with the scheduled dates and times.


All diploma exams must remain SECURED before and during the administration.


