





# How much?

- \$2980.50 per student with 20-25 students going + \$19.50 Rocky View insurance = \$3000.00 total (plus additional insurance \$75 Evolve Tours)
- That includes flights, 2 meals, hotel, guides, bus, mini boat cruise, tips
- Deposit due starting today till October 6, 2016 (right before Thanksgiving weekend) of \$480.50 to secure your place on the trip
- Because prices can go up as result of gas increases and airport tax increases we suggest that you pay your trip in full (if financially possible)
- Once you have paid off your trip you cannot be charged any more your price is locked in – even if gas, etc. still go up.

## Deposit Schedule

- After deposit of \$480.50 = \$2500.00 left
- Nov, jan, feb, march, april deposits due of \$625
- Nov. 30- \$625
- Jan. 30- \$625
- Feb.28- \$625
- March 30- \$625
- \*\*these payments will be set up through school cash
- Or pay up front in full

### Travel Insurance

- Rocky View Insurance is mandatory- \$19.50
- Extra insurance from Evolve: \$39, this covers cancellation, travel medical, lost baggage
- It is recommended to get the extra \$39 insurance but not required

# School Travel Policy- review blue sheet
