### School Travel Policy- review blue sheet

In order to be accorded the privilege of participating in extended field trips, students must demonstrate that they are in good standing at Springbank High, the greater community and school sponsored events.

#### Health Concerns

### Cell phones

- Cell phones are a convenient form of communication but if overused can be disruptive and harmful to a successful group experience.
- IF a cell phone is brought, please check roaming and long distance rates, etc.
- Cell phones should remain silent while on bus, during activities, in a gallery, and at meal time
- Cell phones should be used only in emergencies or during free time.

- No time for laundry during the trip- except emergency situations in a hotel sink
